A reminder that shorts and skorts are not to be worn effective Nov. 1. Students are to wear their sweaters to Mass effective Nov. 1. Please see the handbook requirements below. Thanks so much!

Page 55 Parent/Student Handbook

Students are required to wear "dress" uniforms for school liturgies that include ties and pants for boys, jumpers or skirts for girls. Both girls and boys should wear uniform sweaters for Mass from November 1 through March 1. On warm days, the students will be allowed to remove their sweaters once they are in the church. On cold days when coats are necessary, the students should wear their sweaters under their coats, and remove their coats once they are in church. Shorts and culottes may not be worn from November 1 through March 1; however, students are discouraged from wearing shorts when the temperature drops below 60 degrees. Shirts and blouses should be tucked in at all times except for the girls three-quarter sleeve white blouse that may be worn with the dress uniform skirt.

The uniform should be clean and non-wrinkled with all buttons attached and hem intact. Shirt sleeves should remain buttoned and shirttails tucked in as per policy while a student is on campus.
