5. At our Baptism, the priest or deacon poured water over our head, called us by name, and said, "I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."
6. At the very moment of Baptism, Original Sin is washed away and our souls are filled with God's own life, called grace.
7. We can spend the rest of our lives keeping grace in our souls by receiving often the Sacrament of the Eucharist and the Sacrament of Penance.
8. The seven sacraments are Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Penance, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders, and Matrimony (Marriage). Receiving the sacraments gives us grace and unites us to God.
9. Prayer is powerful. Prayers for people who do not yet know and love God can bring them closer to Him.
